Every Day Counts/ Absence Notification

If you do not have access to a computer and/or internet at your home, you are more than welcome to come along to school and access the

survey through a school computer.

Any students who arrive after 8:45am, please report to the office so the office ladies can issue students with a *late arrival pass* before going to class so that we are able to account for all students on a daily basis

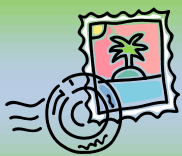
Changes to Daily Routine

YEAR 2 and Year 2/3 NEWS

In Mathematics this term, we start JEMMS (Junior Elementary Math Mastery) This program covers the different strands of mathematics. Each lesson gradually increases in difficulty. We will be continuing our consolidation of addition and subtraction numbers facts. Now that we have been learning the concept of multiplication (groups of), we will be starting to learn our multiplication number facts too. (found in the back of the number facts booklet)

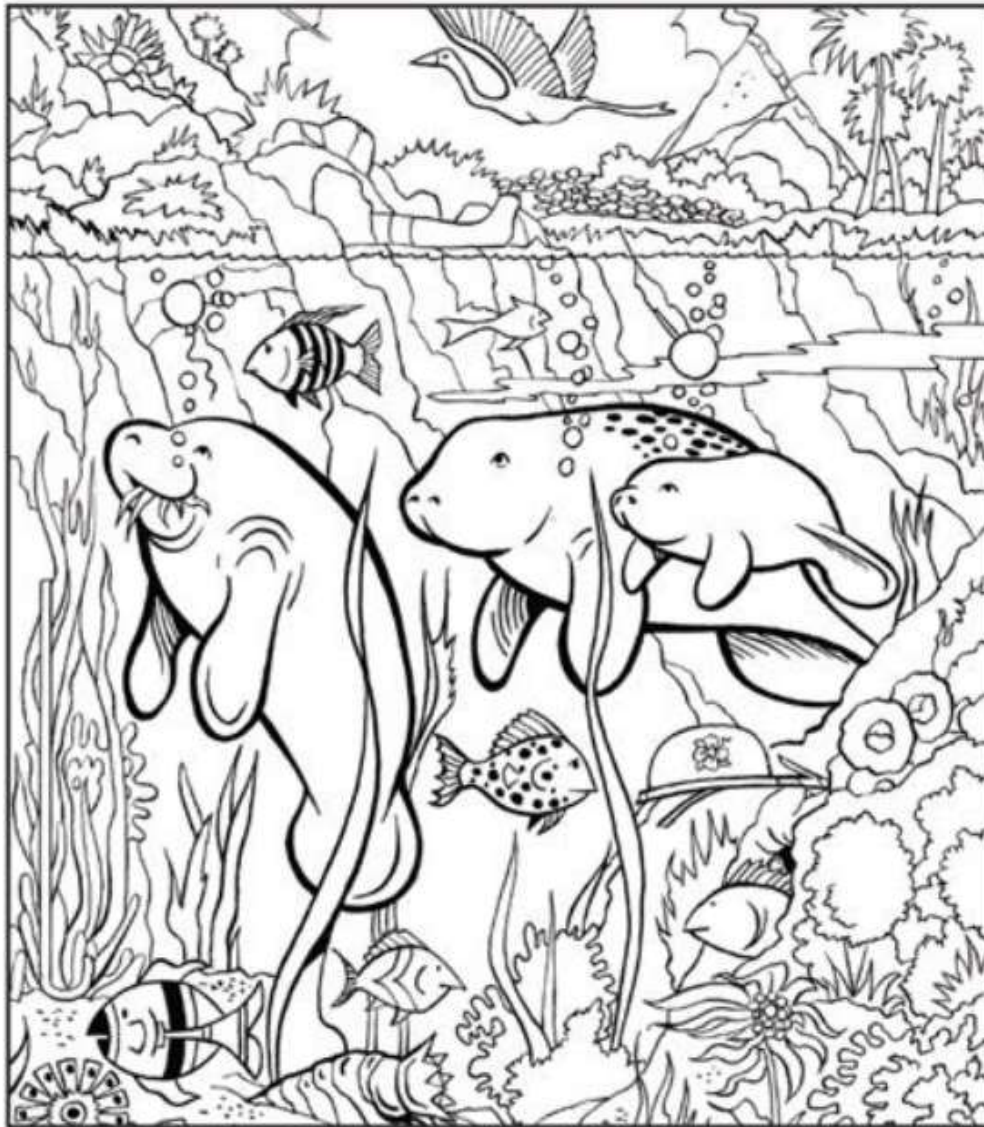
